- Event Date: February 1, 2020
- Event Time:
 - 1pm MST afternoon slack performance
 - #13 24 and 2 Nominate Win You're In (NWYI) WCRA Exemptions in the Bareback Riding from the WCRA Leaderboard
 - #13 24 in the Saddle Bronc Riding from the WCRA Leaderboard
 - 7:30pm MST evening performance
 - #1 12 in the Bareback, Saddle Bronc and Bull Riding from the WCRA Leaderboard
- Check In:
 - Afternoon performance (1pm)
 - Check-in open from 10am 11am. All competitors in the afternoon performance must be checked in by Noon.
 - Evening Performance (7:30pm)
 - Check-in open from 3:30pm 5:30pm. All competitors in the evening performance must checked in by 5:30pm.
- Contestant parking will be located in the back compound of the north-west side of the Maverik Center.

- Livestock draft will occur 2 hours prior to each performance time. Athletes must be present to draft **OR** their stock will be selected for them by random draw. A short athlete meeting will occur immediately following the draft.
 - \circ $\;$ The stock draft order will be in order of the WCRA Leaderboard in each performance.
 - \circ $\;$ The animal that each athlete drafts will determine their pool and order of competition
- Four (4) judges will be used.
- Replay challenges will be available in all disciplines.
- Each contestant competing in the 7:30pm performance will receive one (1) companion ticket. No tickets are required for the afternoon slack performance.
- A BBQ meal will be available for each contestant and one guest at the following times:
 - Afternoon Performance Noon 2pm
 - Evening Performance 6:30 8:30pm
- Qualifier
 - The overall winner of the Lewis Feild Bulls and Broncs event in the Bareback, Saddle Bronc and Bull Riding qualify for the Days of '47 Cowboy Games and Rodeo July 21-25, 2020. (Certain conditions may apply)
 - The overall winner will be determined by the highest score from both bonus rounds per discipline.
- **PBR Cardholders** who compete will receive official PBR velocity level points as dictated by PBR rules and regulations.



FORMAT:

- A minimum of twelve bareback and saddle bronc riding athletes will compete in the afternoon performance and a minimum of 12 bareback, saddle bronc and bull riding athletes will compete in the evening performance.
 - Each performance will include two pools of a minimum of six competitors per discipline.
 - For each performance:
 - The athlete with the highest score from each pool will advance to the bonus round
- Advancement format:
 - The two highest scores from each pool will advance to the WCRA \$1,000,000 Royal City Roundup held Feb. 28 in Kansas City, MO.
 - The highest score in each pool will advance to the bonus round to win the \$2,500 bonus check and the qualification to the 2020 Days of '47 Cowboy Games and Rodeo.
- Order of events will be:
 - Afternoon Performance:
 - Long go-round of Bareback and Saddle Bronc, followed by the bonus round in reverse order – Saddle Bronc and Bareback
 - Evening Performance:
 - Long go-round of Bareback, Saddle Bronc, Bull Riding, followed by the bonus round in reverse order Bull Riding, Saddle Bronc, Bareback Riding.
- Autograph Signing Evening Performance Only
 - Contestants must sign autographs for 30 minutes post event.
 - LFBB reserves the right to approve all contestant sponsor
- If you sign a competition contract to attend and compete and do not, you will not be invited to this event or any other Days of '47 event for two years. The decision may be appealed and heard by an appeal committee.
- Long Go-Round Payout: \$12,500 (Three monies paid: 1st = \$6,250, 2nd = \$3,750, 3rd = \$2,500)
- Bonus Round Payout: \$2,500 (One money paid: 1st = \$2,500)
